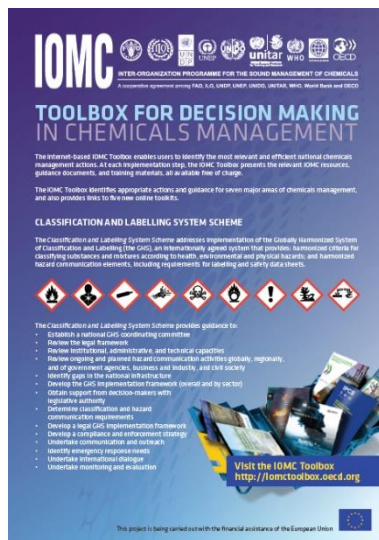
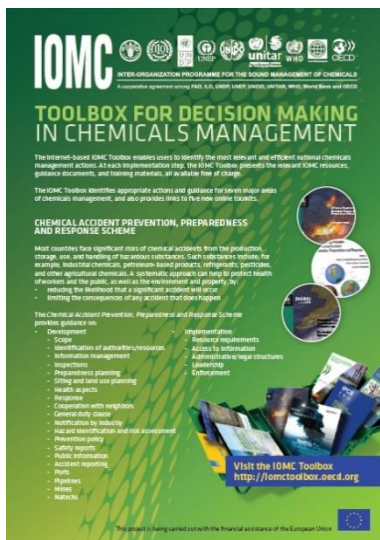
## About IOMC Toolbox

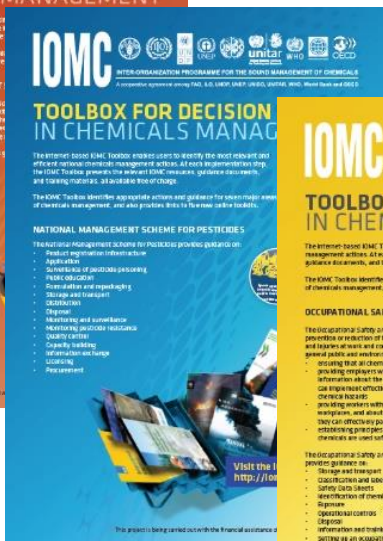
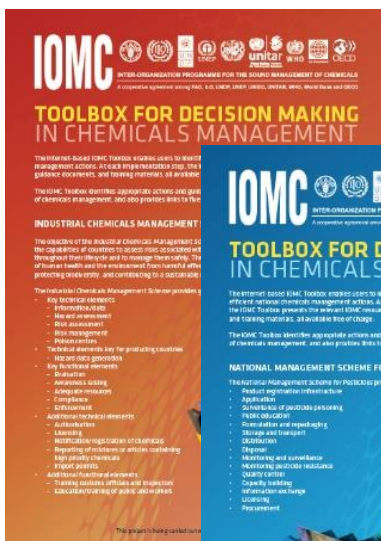


The IOMC Toolbox includes eight management schemes for:

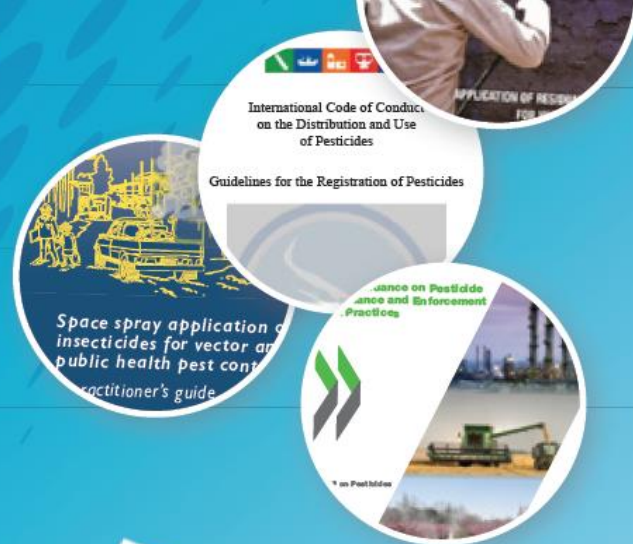




# NATIONAL MANAGEMENT SCHEME FOR PESTICIDES
